
GO DOWN IN HISTORY!

The Connecticut Eastern Railroad Museum is an all volunteer organization that is dedicated to the preservation of railroad history in Eastern Connecticut. We are currently building a museum on the site of the former New Haven Railroad freight yard known as "Columbia Junction". For nearly a century, Willimantic was a major railroad hub for Southern New England.

The museum will be a combination of the restored and reconstructed original facilities, historic buildings from around Eastern Connecticut, and new buildings. So far, the Chaplin station, the Groton freight house, the Versailles crossing shanty, and a Williamntic section house have been obtained and moved to the site and the 1892 roundhouse walls and roof have been reconstructed on the original foundation. These have been arranged to create an authentic railroad setting for the display of railroad locomotives, cars, and artifacts. The museum will be similar to Sturbridge Village and Mystic Seaport and will be a major tourism draw.
